NSW EPA Seek Organics Recycling Processors Contribution

If you are an organics recycling processor then the NSW EPA organics department are looking for your help to better understand your industry needs and wants!

The NSW EPA is encouraging the organics industry in NSW to contribute to new research currently underway to better understand the economics of organics recycling-in NSW.

The EPA Strategy and Policy Unit has commissioned Marsden Jacob Associates to undertake the research, with support from Jackson Environment and Planning and Blue Environment. The study will deliver a point in time snapshot of the current organic waste market and include an analysis of the types and quantities of organics waste being generated in NSW and identify supply and demand drivers.

The project is being funded through the Waste Less, Recycle More [Organics Market Development program](#). It will build on existing data sources, like the annual processor survey, fill data gaps and increase knowledge and understanding of the economics of organics recovery and recycling in NSW in 2017. All contributions to the research will be treated in the strictest confidence and anonymised in the final report.
